#### IPO Report for Community Health Worker Programs

The report in SPECT (IPO Report [Rev. 12/2014]) conforms to the report, data dictionary, and definitions supplied by Maggie on 12/18/14 and 01/05/15. The numbers in the new report are based on an event. The old report (IPO Stat Report) gives data from events as well as from screening forms. Demographics on the new report are taken directly from what you report in SPECT under events. You should use the numbers in the new report to complete your 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter IPO report.

It is crucial that all screenings be attached to an event in order for your reports to accurately reflect your efforts. Regularly scheduled Webinar trainings are provided on this and other topics. Current schedules are also posted on just prior to logging on. To view training schedules from the landing page of <a href="https://www.praspect.org">www.praspect.org</a>, click on Documents > CI, CHV, & IPO/CHW > CHV & CHW Programs Training Schedule. Click on the appropriate link to register. Be sure to register ahead of time.

#### Notes:

- If a 2-page CHS is completed, the data will be calculated under "Completed Screens (2 pg form)", not under "Initial Contacts (1 pg form)".
- If only a 1-page "Initial Contact" is completed, the data will be calculated under "Initial Contacts (1 pg form)".
- To account for every referral appropriately, for example self-referrals from responses to marketing, social media, word of mouth, heard through a friend, etc., you can make a "weekly" event like "self-referrals 1/5-1/9".

#### **Education/Consumers**

Report the total number of programs and total number of participants. Education events include health education, workshops or other group events where more than 1 person is in attendance and an educational presentation is provided.

### **Meetings/Professional Education**

Professional education, networking, advisory groups, meetings with Central Intake, informal meetings.

#### **Outreach**

# of contacts – this is the total number of outreach contacts including community events, street outreach, door to door, public setting or other venues where hard to reach population can be reached and interaction between CHW and client occurred and information was given.

Initial contact and completed screenings and patient profile – this is recorded in SPECT when a 1 page form or 2 page form is completed.

### **Case Management**

# of preconception, pregnant women, interconception women and women with children receiving case management in the quarter.

### **Pregnancy Test**

# of women receiving pregnancy test and recorded on the initial contact form or community health screen form.
