- b. User must provide FHI with an email address through which User will receive FHI correspondence;
- c. Users will only use his/her own username and password;
- d. Users will maintain a secure password and will not share his/her password with any other individual or entity; and

13. Governing Law. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of New Jersey without regard to conflict of law provisions.

14. Assignment. This Agreement and any rights and licenses granted hereunder, may not be transferred or assigned by User, but may be assigned by FHI without restriction. Any attempted transfer or assignment by User in violation hereof shall be null and void.

15. Waiver, Severability. The failure of FHI to exercise or enforce any right or provision of this Agreement does not constitute a waiver of such right or provision. If any provision of this Agreement is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the parties nevertheless agree that the court should endeavor to give effect to the parties' intentions as reflected in the provision, and the other provisions of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
