
PERINATAL RISK ASSESSMENT (PRA) 17P REFERRAL COMMERCIAL TIP SHEET

FORMS & FUNCTIONS	
PRA FORM	Completed at first prenatal visit and submitted to Family Health
	Initiatives via PRA SPECT www.praspect.org within 5 business days
PLAN-SPECIFIC PRIOR	Initiated at first prenatal visit if preterm birth history (≤ 37 weeks or 3
AUTHORIZATION FORM	weeks prior to due date) AND patient ≤ 24 weeks gestation
17P PATIENT LIST	Displays patients eligible for 17P therapy on www.praspect.org

- The goal of a healthy pregnancy is to deliver a baby at 40 weeks gestation. The purpose of 17P therapy is to safeguard women from delivering ≤ 37 weeks gestation
- 17P therapy is only effective if initiated when patient is ≤ 24 weeks gestation
- The PRA is filled out upon a woman's entry into prenatal care. If Para P (preterm birth) is ≥ 1
 AND patient is ≤ 24 weeks gestation, OB staff follow below steps:



- 1. Obtain 17P prescription
- 2. Fill out plan-specific prior authorization form
- 3. Send prescription and plan-specific prior authorization form to insurance company
- 4. Enter 17P outcome on PRA | SPECT

To enter 17P outcome:

Login <u>www.praspect.org</u> > Click 17P > Click Patients in Need of Outcome > Click Show All or first letter of patient's last name > Select outcome > Click Save

To access commercially insured 17P Patient List:

Login www.praspect.org > Click 17P > Click Eligible Non-Medicaid Patients > Click Show All
